Our 2022 AGM was held at the Holiday Inn, followed by an expert panel who answered questions from the floor on 'Being or Becoming an Academy'

The BGA organised a range of Forums throughout the academic year on a number of topics. Our Forums are events which are free of charge to all governors, trustees, and local governors of Barnsley schools, and include a presentation and the opportunity to meet other governors, network and ask questions. Forums have been well-attended and feedback has been very positive.

Forums in 2022-23 included: SEND, Finance for Governors of Maintained Schools and Academies, Safeguarding for Governors, SEND in school, Health & Wellbeing, Being Strategic, and Stakeholder Engagement. We are immensely grateful to colleagues who have done presentations, some probono, to help us in our aim to give governors the professional development in order to carry out their role.

Members of the BGA Executive Committee have continued to be the voice of governors on the Barnsley Alliance, the Schools Forum and TEG. We appreciate hearing our members' views so that we can speak with confidence and legitimacy.
