Parents are legally responsible for ensuring their children get a full time education, BUT data show that there are concerns and challenges around school attendance.

Why don't children and young people attend school?

- Holidays
- Christmas shopping
- Parental attitudes to school
- Mental health concerns
- Poverty, homelessness
- Safeguarding concerns

(FII, bullying, domestic violence, young carers)

- Birthday
- Illness or medical needs
- Poor curriculum
 - Exclusion and suspensions
 - EHE
 - CME

So we need a breadth of response to identify and deal with the cause



Working Together to Improve Attendance (August 2024, 94 pages) is the DfE's response

Support First

- Ensure there's a culture in school of high expectations regarding attendance
- Have the 'right' policy
- Use data to monitor attendance
- Work in partnership with other agencies (local authority) and other schools (for example in your MAT)
- Work in partnership with parents and carers
- Offer personalised support to pupils and families with mental health problems or SEND



Enforcement:

- Attendance Contract
- Education Supervision Order
- Notice to Improve
- Penalty Notice National Framework
- Prosecution in Magistrates Court
- Parenting Order
- Persistent absence when all support has been offered could equal neglect



Governors:

- Are we pro-active in addressing attendance?
- Is our attendance policy published in an accessible format for parents?
- Do we offer all staff sufficient training in attendance and time to prioritise it?
- Do we offer praise and other incentives for good attendance?
- Do we look outwards to collaborate with other schools and find examples of good practice?
- Do we have link governor who pulls together SEND, mental health and behaviour in relation to attendance?
- Is our curriculum exciting so that children want to come to school and learn?
